## OCF PROVINCIAL QUOTAS TO CEC REGIONALS

The CEC determines the eligibility criteria for their events as well as the Provincial Quota allocated to each PSO per category for Regionals:

- The Provincial Quota for each category is based on the number of registered athletes in the category
- The OCF Provincial Quota for each Open gender is 30
- The OCF Provincial Quota for all youth categories is 10 (except for Junior Girls where we have fewer than 20 athletes)
- For Junior Girls (where we have 12 registered athletes), the OCF Provincial Quota is 8

The OCF fills our Provincial Quotas according to section 8 of our Rules:

- We fill our quota with the top-ranked Ontario athletes who meet the CEC's eligibility criteria up to the max of our quota
- Rankings are calculated using the total of each competitor's best two (2) results in the discipline calculated using Series Points: we take the points for each result (Local 1, Local 2 and Provincials), assign points, add the top 2, then rank based on this total
- Series points can be found in section 5.5 of our rules
- As with all OCF rankings, Local results are adjusted as if non-residents had not competed
- When there are ties, Series Points are awarded equally to the tied competitors accounting for the placements held by the competitors involved
- Anyone who is pre-qualified to Regionals by the CEC is extra quota (does not take a spot in our quota)
- this "two data point" ranking is a change from last year where we chose our quota for CEC events using just one data point (Provincials)
